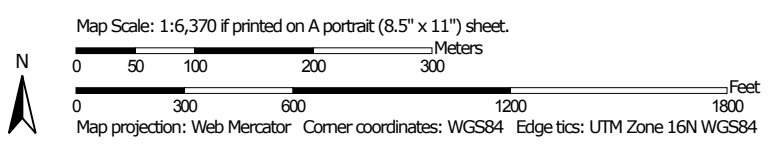


Soil Map—Fayette County Area, Part of Fayette County, Kentucky
